

Kinetic AR Hierarchy Technical Reference Guide

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Accounts Receivable Transaction Hierarchy

This hierarchy is a summary of common general ledger (GL) transactions posted from within the Accounts Receivable (AR) module.






This hierarchy assumes your company uses an unmodified version of the Standard posting rules delivered with the Epicor application. If you use the Extended posting rules, or if you need information regarding an AR transaction that is not listed on this hierarchy, refer to GL Transaction Type Maintenance and review the details of the AR Invoice posting rules.

Cash Receipt Adjustment

The Adjust Cash Receipt transaction combines two existing GL transaction types, the **Reverse Cash Receipt** and the **AR Payment** (Cash Receipt Entry) GL transaction types.

The Cash Receipt Adjustment transaction does not have posting rules or input documents. It is a posting algorithm that posts, confirms or terminates the reverse cash receipt and AR payment as one combined transaction.
